

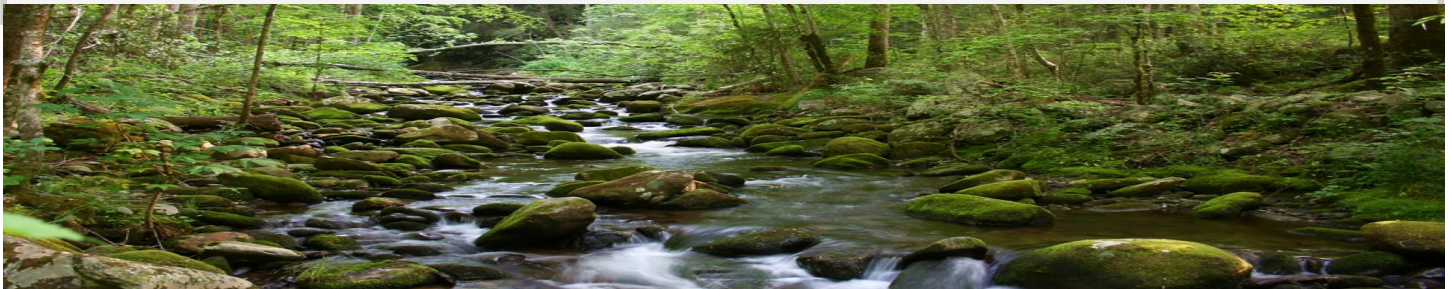


## Master Watershed Steward Program Lehigh & Northampton Counties
