





A THE RIDGE IS UNDER THREAT

- // Development / Almost every part of the Ridge is vulnerable to residential and commercial expansion.
- // Pollution / State forests and remote areas of the Ridge are common targets of illegal trash dumping.
- // Invasive Plants / Non-native plants are damaging trees and overtaking indigenous flora.
- # Energy / Energy infrastructure development threatens sensitive habitats.
- // Climate Change / Globally increasing carbon emissions impact all communities along the Ridge.
